



Sheet Metal Fabricator/Installer

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

This position reports to the Sheet Metal Supervisor. Uses knowledge and skills acquired of various sheet metal roofing systems and components to deconstruct and install roof systems in a safe manner to the manufacturer's specifications.

- Reads and interprets blueprints and sketches to determine sequence and methods of fabricating, assembling, and installing sheet metal products.
- Sets-up and operates fabricating machines such as shears, brakes, and forming rolls, to cut, bend, block and form, or straighten materials.
- Repairs and maintains sheet metal products.
- Cleans work area, machines, tools, and equipment.
- Performs tear off, staging of materials, destruction, and installation of roof material. Monitors jobsite cleanliness and protection of resources onsite including security of materials, tools, equipment, and roof structure throughout all stages of project.
- Ability to perform work frequently without detailed direction of Foreperson.
- Maintains good working order of tools and equipment by performing basic maintenance and bringing complex maintenance needs to the attention of the Project Coordinator.
- Ability to perform continuous physical labor including walking, standing, reaching, bending, kneeling, and repetitive motions of hands and wrists, frequently climbing ladders, grasping various equipment and tools, handling of equipment and materials,
- Must have the physical ability to push, pull, carry, and lift 75 lbs, constant standing and extensive close work, and to work outdoors in hot or cold weather.
- This position requires ability to work flexible work schedule, including occasional overtime and weekends. Infrequent out of town work. Own reliable transportation to various locations.
- Other duties as assigned.

Preferred Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- 3 years sheet metal experience
- 1 year experience with brake/large press operating procedures
- Experience in commercial, residential, and sheet metal industry
- Must hold a valid driver's license with a good driving history
- Understand English verbal and written work instructions, communicate project feedback, or notify Project Manager of issues in English
